Today begins the second week of school closure due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We realize that we are in a very uneasy time filled with new experiences for all of us. Fort Frye Local Schools will continue to offer academic, food, and/or mental health services using the following procedures.

\*Last week, students should have completed Blizzard Bag assignments. This week, teachers are sending out a set of weekly assignments. There will be NO MORE than three assignments per course for the entire week so students should not have five days of school assignments to complete. The younger grades will focus primarily on Math, Reading and Writing. All lessons, except for College Credit Plus, will focus on reteaching, reinforcing, or extending knowledge and skills that have already been taught.

\*College Credit Plus classes will follow the procedures recommend by the college institution.

\*Tuesday will be Grab and Go meals where an adult guardian can pick up student meals (5 free lunches and 5 free breakfasts per child) at the school site from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. or 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Please register one time in advance by calling 740-984-2376 ext. 1000 to arrange for meals. You do not have to call each week unless you decide to discontinue this service.

\*Families with enrolled students can also check out a Chromebook (one per family) at the Grab and Go on Tuesday, but they do not have to call ahead to reserve a Chromebook.

\*If students are having difficulty accessing online assignments, please email the teacher or call the school or superintendent's office so that hard copies can be arranged. This must be done well in advance of the Tuesday Grab and Go time.

\*The District has checked into hot spot internet resources for families, and none are accessible until at least after April 15. Further, if you have poor cell phone reception, a hot spot will likely not work. There are some places offering free WiFi to families and our parking lots offer access to free WiFi.

\*If your child was receiving mental health services at school and has not been contacted to arrange services or support, please contact the mental health provider or the building principal.
