### 3<sup>rd</sup> Show Readiness

#### Local

Anytime during grades 9-12, students must document 120+ participation hours or provide proof of an award of recognition/achievement for

- Community Service Seal – a community service project
- Student Engagement Seal – extracurricular activities
- Fine and Performing Arts Seal – a skill demonstration

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Show Competency

#### Earn State AIR Tests Competency Score of 684 on both

- **Algebra I** (Integrated Math I is an acceptable replacement) **and**
- **ELA 2**

(ELA 1 removed and Geometry pending removal with waiver from Feds; other AIR Tests are still mandatory and show up in “3<sup>rd</sup> Show Readiness”)

#### OR

Complete 1 of 3 alternative ways:

1. Earn credit for one math and/or English course through CCP (College Credit Plus) or
2. Demonstrate Career Experience and Technical Skill: Complete 2 demonstrations of competency through foundational and supporting options (in table below) or
3. Enter a contract to enlist in the military upon graduation

### 2 Seals Required (1 of which must be Ohio)

#### Ohio

- Military Enlistment Seal – under contract at time of graduation
- Technology Seal – B or higher in CCP class or complete a course offered by the school that meets department guidelines
- Industry Recognized Credential – earn 12 point approved credential
- Citizenship Seal – proficient+ in both American History and American Government exam or B or higher in CCP classes
- Ohio Means Jobs Readiness Seal – proof of employability skills with school, work, and community consultation
- Seal of Biliteracy – proficiency on assessments in world language and English
- College Ready Seal – remediation free scores on ACT (Eng 18, Read 22, Math 22)
- Science Seal – proficient+ on Biology exam or B or higher in CCP class
- Honors Diploma Seal – earn one of 6 Honors Diplomas



Pick 2 of the seals bulleted in 3<sup>rd</sup> Show Readiness. Students are encouraged to start with the Ohio Means Jobs Readiness Seal, then select 1 more.
