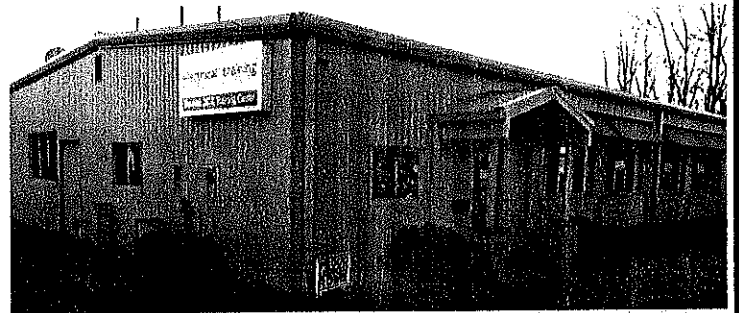

What are the program specifics?

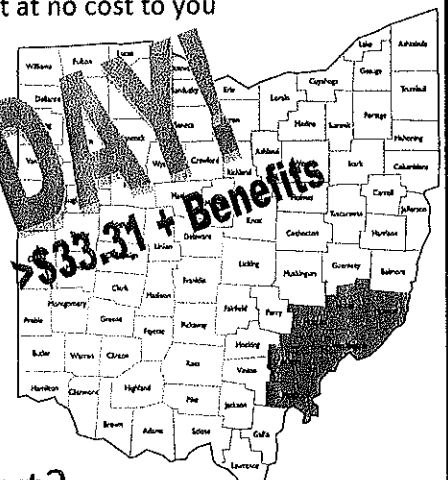
- ◆ 5 year apprenticeship program
