

Marietta Teacher Pathway Program

What is the Marietta Teacher Pathway?

The Marietta Teacher Pathway is a program intended to try to help the school districts in Washington County, Ohio identify their best and brightest young people who may be interested in careers in Education and provide them with a start to their path to become a professional educator. The rural nature of our county makes it challenging to recruit talented teachers in all content and developmental levels. This program will allow local students to begin their journey to becoming a teacher close to home in hopes that upon graduation they will remain in our region.

What are the Benefits of Participating in the Marietta Teacher Pathway?

Becoming a member of the Marietta Teacher Pathway program has a number of benefits:

- You will have an opportunity to take up to 5 classes in your junior and senior years
 that will transfer into an Ohio college or university and further your work to become
 a teacher. These courses will be taught in a number of different models by Marietta
 College through a variety of modalities, including face to face summer classes (EDUC
 110), online courses (EDUC 202, 253, and PSYC 101), and night classes (EDUC 130).
 There is a chart below that will indicate the order of the classes for the first
 cohort.
- Coursework that requires you to engage in field experiences with younger students so that you can make sure that a profession as a teacher is right for you.
- Textbooks that are paid for by our grant funds.
- Participation in the Educators Rising area chapter events. The chapter will be traveling to the state conference for Educators Rising this year...and there is a grant that will pay for it!
- Opportunities to interact with college students to ease your own future transition into a college setting. You will be assigned a student mentor who will show you the





campus, answer questions, and even meet with you to attend college activities and events.

A chance to work closely with one or more Marietta College Education faculty. One
of these faculty members will serve as your academic advisor for your work on the
Pathway program.

What is my Path?

As mentioned above you will have opportunities to take the following classes. The proposed order of the courses is included below as well. *Please note that you are not eligible to take PSYC 101 until you have successfully completed EDUC 110.*

Get on the Path!

If you are interested in joining the Marietta Teacher Pathway, take the following steps:

- 1. Talk with your guidance counselor about the program to make sure it is the right fit for you, and that you have the required GPA and test scores for participation in College Credit Plus.
- 2. Complete the application for the College Credit Plus Program with the assistance of your guidance counselor (found at the end of this packet).
- 3. Complete your College Credit Plus Letter of Intent and submit it to your guidance counselor **by April 1**st.
- 4. Complete the Educator Pathway application and ask your guidance counselor to submit it to Marietta College Admissions no later than **April 15**th.
- 5. Be prepared to meet with your Marietta College mentor to discussion your career plans **by May 15**th.
- 6. Plan to attend your first course, *EDUC 110: Issues in Education* beginning June 3rd, 2019. Please note that this course is a blended course. Participants will be on campus for a full day of EDUC 110 for the first week in June. The remainder of June will be an opportunity to work directly with students during the Reading Camp, where they will serve as junior counselors for the program.
