Dear Graduates of the Class of 2018 and Parents/Guardians:

As we approach graduation on Saturday, May 26, it is important for seniors to know the following:

\*\*\*We invite all seniors and their parents/guardians to attend the **SENIOR SHOWCASE AWARDS ASSEMBLY on Monday, May 21, at 8:30 AM in the Fort Frye High School auditorium** senior awards and recognitions will take place during this program. The intent is to showcase the honors earned by the members of the Class of 2018. Senior Showcase Forms will be distributed to ALL seniors on April 30<sup>th</sup> and need to be returned to the HS Guidance Office by May 14. Additional copies will be available in the Guidance Office or on the Guidance Web page under the scholarship heading>Senior Showcase Sheet.

\*\*\***MANDATORY GRADUATION PRACTICE** will be held on **Friday, May 25, at 9:00 AM. Students must bring their caps and gowns for the class picture (Cap and gown needs to be ordered by March 1st)**. In addition, boys need to wear jeans or long pants and girls need to wear skirts or shorts. No flip-flops are permitted. Students are to come directly to the Fort Frye HS auditorium for seating. The class picture will then be taken followed by a walk through of the ceremony. **If you are not at the practice, you will not participate in Saturday's graduation ceremony. No exceptions. No excuses.** This is a regularly scheduled school day; attendance is not optional. You will be released from practice DO NOT leave without Mrs. Lewis or Mrs. Walsh knowing.

*After the rehearsal, the class officers and advisors have planned a luncheon catered by The Boat House for all graduates who are current with their class dues.*

\*\*\***Attention Career Center Students – if you are NOT planning to participate in the graduation ceremonies at the high school, please call Mrs. Lewis as soon as possible.**

\*\*\***GRADUATION will be Saturday, May 26, at 1:00 PM.** Seniors are to report to the auditorium by **12:15 PM**. Proper attire is outlined on the accompanying paper, and will be discussed during the graduation practice. We ask that parents/guardians ensure that your graduate is properly dressed for graduation. Proper dress is mandatory for participation in the ceremonies. We will be mailing this letter again on May 1<sup>st</sup> just as a reminder.

In case of inclement weather, graduation will be held in the high school gymnasium. Doors will open at 12:00 noon.
