

## FORT FRYE LOCAL SCHOOLS BULLYING REPORT 2018-2019 School Year

Below is information related to the number of reported bullying incidents and the number of these incidents that were confirmed as meeting the definition of bullying during the 2018- 2019 school year.

To be considered bullying, there are three components in the definition. A person is bullied when he or she is exposed, repeatedly and over time, to negative actions on the part of one or more other persons, and he or she has difficulty defending himself/herself.

This definition includes three important components: 1. Bullying is aggressive behavior that involves unwanted, negative actions. 2. Bullying involves a pattern of behavior repeated over time. 3. Bullying involves an imbalance of power or strength.
